

# MEDICINE CABINET INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


**NOTE:** Please read and follow instructions step-by-step. Improper installation will cause door misalignment and cabinet frame warpage.

### **TOOLS NEEDED**

- Safety Glasses
- Level
- Phillips Head Screw Driver

- Measuring Tape
- Square
- Electric Drill
- Pencil

# RECESSED CABINET INSTALLATION



**Note:** Cabinet may be mounted so door opens left to right or right to left. Not includes Tilting Mirror Cabinets.

- 1. Prepare rough opening for cabinet. See charts below for cabinet model and wall opening.
- 2. Provide clearance slots for four (4) hinge sheet metal screws and two (2) magnetic touch latch sheet metal screws.
  - 3. Use four (4) #10x2" Phillips head screws (supplied) to mount cabinet into wall opening.
  - 4. Use Level and Square to make sure cabinet properly aligned.

**Note:** DO NOT tighten screws more than necessary. Special care MUST be taken to insure that cabinet is mounted plumb and true. Over tightening and improper mounting will result in cabinet distortion and poor door alignment. Wall opening dimensions MUST be held closely to allow proper installation. See FIG 1.

5. The cabinet door may be adjusted slightly toward or away from the cabinet by loosening four (4) hinge screws. Tighten screws when the adjustment is complete. Only available Flush Mount (FM), Semi Recessed (SR), Wall Mount (WM) and all Tri-View Cabinets with European style hinges.

#### SURFACE MOUNT CABINET INSTALLATION

Note: Model Numbers XX- are replaced by Partially Recessed (PR) or Surface Mount (SM).

- 1. Position cabinet at desired location. Place a level at top of the cabinet to make sure it is straight. Use pencil to trace top and bottom outlines of the cabinet.
- 2. Cabinet still held in place, open the door, using pencil mark the holes on the supporting wall.
- 3. Set cabinet a side. Drill pilot holes into pencil marks on wall.
- 4. Position the cabinet back on wall, line up installation holes.
- 5. Drive screws into each hole to secure the cabinet to the wall.
